2025 INTERNATIONAL STUDENT PROSPECTUS

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Yunnan University of Chinese Medicine was established in 1960. It is one of the second batch of higher undergraduate institutions of Chinese medicine in China. It was granted the right to confer master's degrees in 1986 and the right to confer doctoral degrees in 2018. The university has more than 16,000 full-time students. There are 11 faculties and 2 teaching departments for public courses. It has one first-level discipline doctoral degree program, four first-level discipline master's degree programs, five master's professional degree programs, and 25 undergraduate majors.

The university attaches great importance to foreign exchanges and cooperation. It has successively established exchange and cooperation relations with more than 30 countries or regions such as the United States, Australia, France, Germany, Canada, Switzerland, South Korea, Thailand, Vietnam, Indonesia, Hong Kong and Taiwan, and has carried out activities such as student exchanges, teacher exchanges and joint scientific research. The university has become the most influential international platform of traditional medicine education exchange and cooperation in South Asia and Southeast Asia.

The university has recruited and trained more than 3,000 international students from countries such as the United States, France, Canada, Belgium, Sweden, South Korea, Japan, India, Indonesia, Kazakhstan, Vietnam, Thailand, Laos, Myanmar and Malaysia. Currently, nearly 200 international students are studying at the university.

I.Application Requirements

- 1. Valid passports of Non-Chinese citizens holders, in good health, complying with Chinese laws and regulations and the rules and regulations of Yunnan University of Chinese Medicine;
- 2. For Chinese language learners: High school diploma or above, not exceeding 35 years old;
- 3. Undergraduate: High school diploma, Chinese proficiency level of HSK (Hanyu Shuiping Kaoshi) 5 or above, not exceeding 25 years old;
- 4. Master's students: Bachelor's degree or above in a medical related field, with a Bachelor's degree in Medicine, Chinese proficiency level of HSK 5 or above, and not exceeding 35 years old;
- 5. Doctoral students: Master's degree or above in medical related majors, with a medical master's degree, a Chinese proficiency level of HSK 5 or above, not exceeding 40 years old.

Before July 30th, 2025

III.Application Materials

- 1.Scanned copy of the passport photo page.
- 2. Notarized certificate of the highest educational attainment, including scanned copies of the graduation certificate and academic transcripts (the name on the graduation certificate must be consistent with that on the passport).
- (1) The scanned copy of the original document must be provided.
- For materials that are not in Chinese or English, a notarized Chinese or English translations must be provided.
- (2) Fresh graduates should provide a certificate of expected graduation when applying (the expected time of obtaining the degree certificate should be earlier than August 31, 2025. When registering and reporting for duty, the original graduation certificate must be provided for inspection).
- 3.Study plan.
- 4. HSK Level 5 or above certificate (valid for two years).
- 5. "Physical Examination Record for Foreigners" (valid for six months).
- 6.Certificate of no criminal record (fresh graduates can submit a certificate of good performance at school).
- 7.Self-funded students must provide a financial guarantee certificate (bank deposit certificate or the work income certificate of their financial guarantors).

- 8. Other award certificates or proofs;
- 9. Those under the age of 18 must submit the entrusted certification documents signed by their legal quardians in China;
- 10.International students who are already studying in Chinese schools and apply to study in our university should also provide:
- (1) The transfer consent letter, academic transcripts or completion certificates of the school where they are currently studying, which must be stamped with the official seal.
- (2) Copies of visas or residence permits in China.
- (3) Those who are teaching or working in China must provide the expected termination of the employment contract of the employing unit.
- *Precautions: All kinds of certificates, proofs and academic transcripts uploaded must be scanned copies of the original Chinese or English documents or notarized documents. For materials that are not in Chinese or English, both the original documents and the notarized Chinese or English translations must be uploaded simultaneously. Please use a scanner to scan the relevant documents before uploading. Documents photographed by mobile phones or cameras will not be accepted.

(1) Chinese Language Students

Length of schooling: One year

Major: Chinese Language

(2) Undergraduate Students

Length of schooling: Five years

Majors: Chinese Medicine; Acupuncture-Moxibustion and Tuina; Pediatrics of Chinese Medicine, Orthopedics and Traumatology of Chinese Medicine, Rehabilitation of Chinese Medicine, Health Preservation of Chinese Medicine, Dai Medicine, Clinical Medicine of Integrated Chinese and Western Medicine.

Length of schooling: Four years

Majors: Chinese Materia Medica, Nursing,

(3) Master's Degree Candidates

Length of schooling: Three years

Majors: Basic Theory of Chinese Medicine, Clinical Basis of Chinese Medicine, Diagnostics of Chinese Medicine, Internal Medicine of Chinese Medicine, Surgery of Chinese Medicine, Orthopedics and Traumatology of Chinese Medicine, Gynecology of Chinese Medicine, Pediatrics of Chinese Medicine, Acupuncture-Moxibustion and Tuina, Ethnic Medicine, Chinese Materia Medica, Pharmacy, Nursing, Anthropology of Chinese Medicine.

(4) Doctoral Degree Candidates

Length of schooling: Three years

Majors: Basic Theory of Chinese Medicine, Clinical Basis of Chinese Medicine, Internal Medicine of Chinese Medicine, Surgery of Chinese Medicine, Acupuncture-Moxibustion and Tuina, Ethnic Medicine.

V. Application and Admission Procedures

- 1. Online Application: Applicants should log in to the International Student Management Platform of Yunnan University of Chinese Medicine at: https://ynutcm.at0086.cn/StuApplication/Login.aspx to register, fill in the application information online, and upload clear electronic materials.
- 2. Checking the Application Status: Applicants can inquire about the progress and status of their applications through the application system. They should check the information in the system and check their emails regularly so as not to miss important notices.
- 3. Checking the Application Results: The university will conduct qualification reviews and entrance examinations based on the application materials submitted by applicants and admit students on a merit basis. Applicants can log in at https://ynutcm.at0086.cn/StuApplication/Login.aspx to check the admission results.
- ★ Precautions: When applying online, applicants need to ensure that their names, passport numbers, and dates of birth are consistent with the information on their passports. The email addresses and the mailing addresses for receiving the Admission Notices must be accurate; otherwise, they will not be able to receive the electronic JW202 Form and the Admission Notice.

VI. Visa Application and Registration for School Enrollment

Those who have been admitted should take their ordinary passports, the Admission Notices, the Visa Application Form for Foreign Students to Come to China (JW202 Form), the Physical Examination Record for Foreigners and the original physical examination reports to Chinese embassies (consulates) abroad to apply for the X1 visa for studying in China.

Those who have been admitted must go through the registration formalities at Yunnan University of Chinese Medicine within the time specified in the notice. New students must bring the original degree certificates with them when enrolling in the university for the school to recheck their enrollment qualifications. Those who do not meet the enrollment requirements will have their enrollment qualifications canceled.

VII. Scholarship Programs

1. Yunnan Provincial Government Scholarship

It provides tuition fees, accommodation fees, insurance in China

2. Scholarship for International Students of Yunnan University of Chinese Medicine

Full Scholarship: It provides tuition fees and accommodation fees.

Half Scholarship: It reduces half of the tuition fees and accommodation fees. Please log in to the website at https://ynutcm.at0086.cn/StuApplication/Login.aspx before June 30th to submit relevant materials for application.

ENROLLMENT GUIDE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

A GUIDE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Dear students,

Hello! Welcome to Yunnan University of Chinese Medicine for study! In order to help you register and enroll smoothly, please go through the relevant enrollment formalities as required by the "Enrollment Guide".

I. Materials to be Submitted

- 1. The completed "Application Form for International Students' Study at Yunnan University of Chinese Medicine".
- 2. Notarized copies and translations of the high school or above graduation certificates in Chinese or English.
- 3. Copies of HSK scores and certificates.
- 4. Valid passports (The validity period of the passport must be longer than your study period in China).
- 5. "International Travel Health Certificate" (The health certificates issued by overseas medical institutions must be confirmed by the Yunnan Entry-Exit Inspection and Quarantine Bureau).
- 6. The original accommodation registration certificate issued by the local police station of the place of residence.
- 7.Ten recent 2-inch front-facing, half-length, bareheaded photos.

II. Related Fees

- 1. Registration fee: 800 Yuan.
- 2.Insurance premium: 800 Yuan per person per year.
- 3. Tuition fee for Chinese language students: 12,000 Yuan/person /year.
- 4. Tuition fee for undergraduate students: 22,000 Yuan/person /year.
- 5. Tuition fee for master's degree candidates: 30,000 Yuan/person /year.
- 6.Textbook fee: Based on the courses taken in the semester, approximately 150 300 Yuan/person/semester.
- 7.Accommodation fee: 6,000 Yuan per year for a single room, 3,000 Yuan per year for a double room, 2,100 Yuan per year for a triple room, and 1,500 Yuan per year for a quadruple room.
- 8. Meal fee: The school has a cafeteria dedicated to students, and the meal fee depends on individual consumption levels.

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III. Residence in China

1.International students who enter China with an "X1" visa must submit their passports, "International Travel Health Certificates", the original accommodation declaration certificates issued by the local police stations of their places of residence and other materials to the School of International Education of our university within 7 days from the date of entry. The staff of the School of International Education will be responsible for applying for the "Residence Permit for Foreigners".

2.Extension of Residence Permit: International students must submit their passports, "International Travel Health Certificates" and the original accommodation declaration certificates issued by the local police stations of their places of residence to the School of International Education of the university two weeks before the expiration of their residence permits. The School of International Education will be responsible for handling the extension procedures of the "Residence Permit for Foreigners". If the residence permit expires due to the reasons of the international students themselves, they shall bear the fine of 500 Yuan per day imposed by the public security organs and relevant penalties.

3. Visa Application for Family Members of International Students: The School of International Education can handle the visa application procedures in Kunming for the family members of international students, but the following must be provided:

- (1) Valid passports;
- (2) Two recent 2-inch front-facing, half-length, bareheaded photos;
- (3) The original accommodation registration certificates issued by the local police stations of their places of residence;
- (4) Foreign spouses must also provide marriage certificates; foreign children must also provide kinship certificates; guardians must also provide the power of attorney of the parents of the international students. Relevant certificates issued by overseas institutions must be authenticated by Chinese embassies or consulates abroad. Certificates in languages other than English must be translated into Chinese by professional translation agencies or companies.

Moreover, the validity period of the visas applied for by the family members of international students shall not exceed the valid period of the visas or residence permits of the international students.

4.If the items (such as name, reason for residence, passport number) on the residence permit change or the address changes, the passports, "International Travel Health Certificates", the original accommodation declaration certificates issued by the local police stations of their places of residence and other materials must be submitted to the School of International Education of the university within 7 days after the change. The staff of the School of International Education will be responsible for applying for the change procedures. If the international students fail to handle the change procedures in time due to personal reasons, all consequences shall be borne by the international students themselves.
